



Kaliro, Uganda



GOAL: Increase access to safe water, sanitation and hygiene for **30,000** vulnerable children and families.

THE REALITY: Women and children are the most vulnerable to suffering harm and physical ailments from the long journey for water, lack of adequate sanitation, and poor hygiene.

3 HRS 3 hours is the average amount of time spent and journeying for water each day.

3% Only 3% have a safe and dignifying latrine.

12% 12% of homes have a handwashing facility with soap and water.



Kaliro District
Uganda

Kaliro, in eastern Uganda, is a semi-arid district of patchwork grasslands and forests, where many families farm or herd animals for subsistence. Due to its rural location, Kaliro remains under-developed and faces pressing social issues due to poor water access, sanitation, and hygiene.
