



Mayuge, Uganda



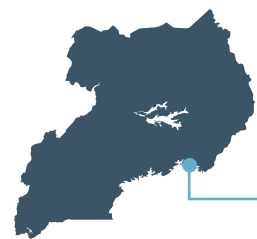
GOAL: Increase access to safe water, sanitation, and hygiene for **25,000** vulnerable children and families.

THE REALITY: Women and children are the most vulnerable to suffering harm and physical ailments from the long journey for water, lack of adequate sanitation, and poor hygiene.

53% of people in rural areas do not have access to safe water

1548 Average number of people using one well in a community

100:1 Ratio of children to toilets available at schools

Mayuge, in the eastern region of Uganda, has one of the lowest WASH coverage percentages in eastern Uganda with 47% water access in the rural areas. In areas that do have water access, boreholes are overcrowded and do not supply enough water. There is an average of 1548 people per borehole, compared to the government standard of one borehole for 300 people.
